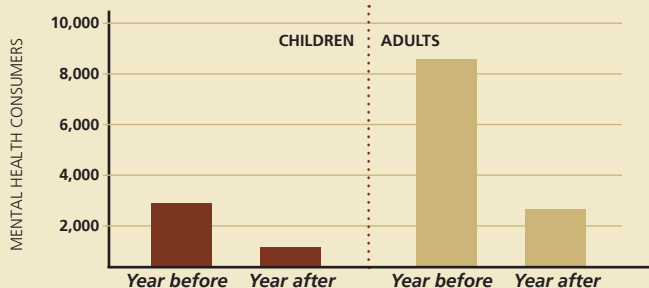




## Oregon Mental Health Outcomes

The State of Oregon invested \$608.9 million in mental health treatment during the 2005-07 biennium and served more than 109,000 Oregonians each year. The outcomes achieved with these investments benefit the clients, their families and the entire state.

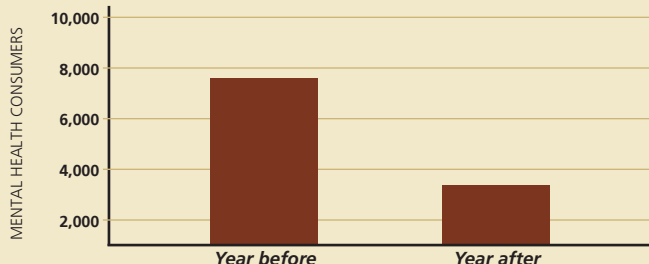
### MENTAL HEALTH CONSUMERS ARRESTED THE YEAR BEFORE AND THE YEAR AFTER MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES BEGAN



This represents a decrease of approximately 6,000 adult arrests. Based on Oregon Criminal Justice Commission data, the minimum taxpayer cost for an adult arrest is \$1,036. Oregon saved at least \$6.2 million per year. This does not take into account other costs for conviction, probation, jail and associated expenses.

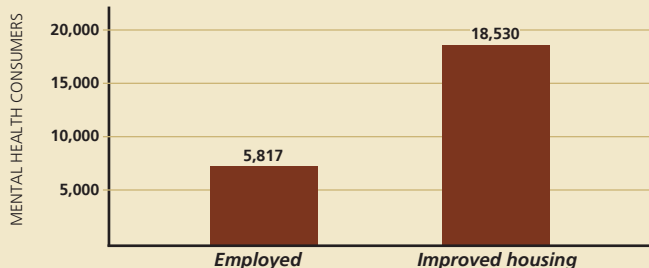
### CHILDREN/ADOLESCENTS RECEIVING SERVICES WHO WERE SUSPENDED OR EXPELLED FROM SCHOOL THE YEAR BEFORE AND THE YEAR AFTER MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES BEGAN



Approximately 4,200 fewer children/adolescents were expelled or suspended from school, as a result of receiving mental health services. These children received 12,600 more days of education as a result of mental health services, assuming an average suspension of three days.

### ADULTS WHO WERE EMPLOYED OR IMPROVED THEIR HOUSING AS A RESULT OF MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES IN 2006

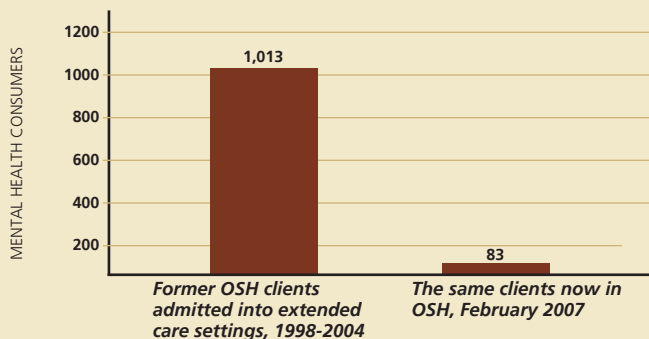


During 2006, 5,800 people in community mental health services became employed. Assuming they work 20 hours per week at minimum wage (\$7.80) for a year, their total income is \$48,859,200.

The value of improved housing is critical to supporting recovery and stability.

### VALUE OF EXTENDED CARE PROJECTS IN KEEPING PATIENTS OUT OF OREGON STATE HOSPITALS (OSH)



A review of all 1,013 patients admitted into extended care projects between 1998 and 2004 shows that only 83 are back in state hospitals today.

- » Oregon State Hospital costs \$558.16/day General Fund (GF).
- » Extended care setting GF costs range from \$123.46/day for a secure residential bed to \$21.20/day for an adult foster home bed.
