## Addictions Services

### Prevention

- Education and early intervention provided at Brookings, Gold Beach and Port Orford; early intervention services for youth also provided by the Juvenile Department throughout the county
- Alternative activities for youth provided on contract by the local Commission on Children & Families in Gold Beach, Brookings and Port Orford
- Gambling prevention and early intervention services

### Outpatient Treatment

Screening, assessment, individual and group therapy, including co-occurring disorders treatment\* for adults and adolescents, youth services provided at the Juvenile Department in Gold Beach and Brookings, programs for domestic violence intervention and anger management, gambling treatment

### Residential and Detox Services

Referrals to available providers statewide. No detox facilities on the south coast, referrals to Curry General Hospital

### Recovery Services

Case management available in Brookings and Gold Beach

### Program Administration

Eligibility determination, quality assurance, foster care licensing, family support, contracts and protective services.

### Service Coordination

Crisis services, referral, person-centered planning, monitoring, advocacy, and information and training.

### Residential, Vocational and Transportation Services

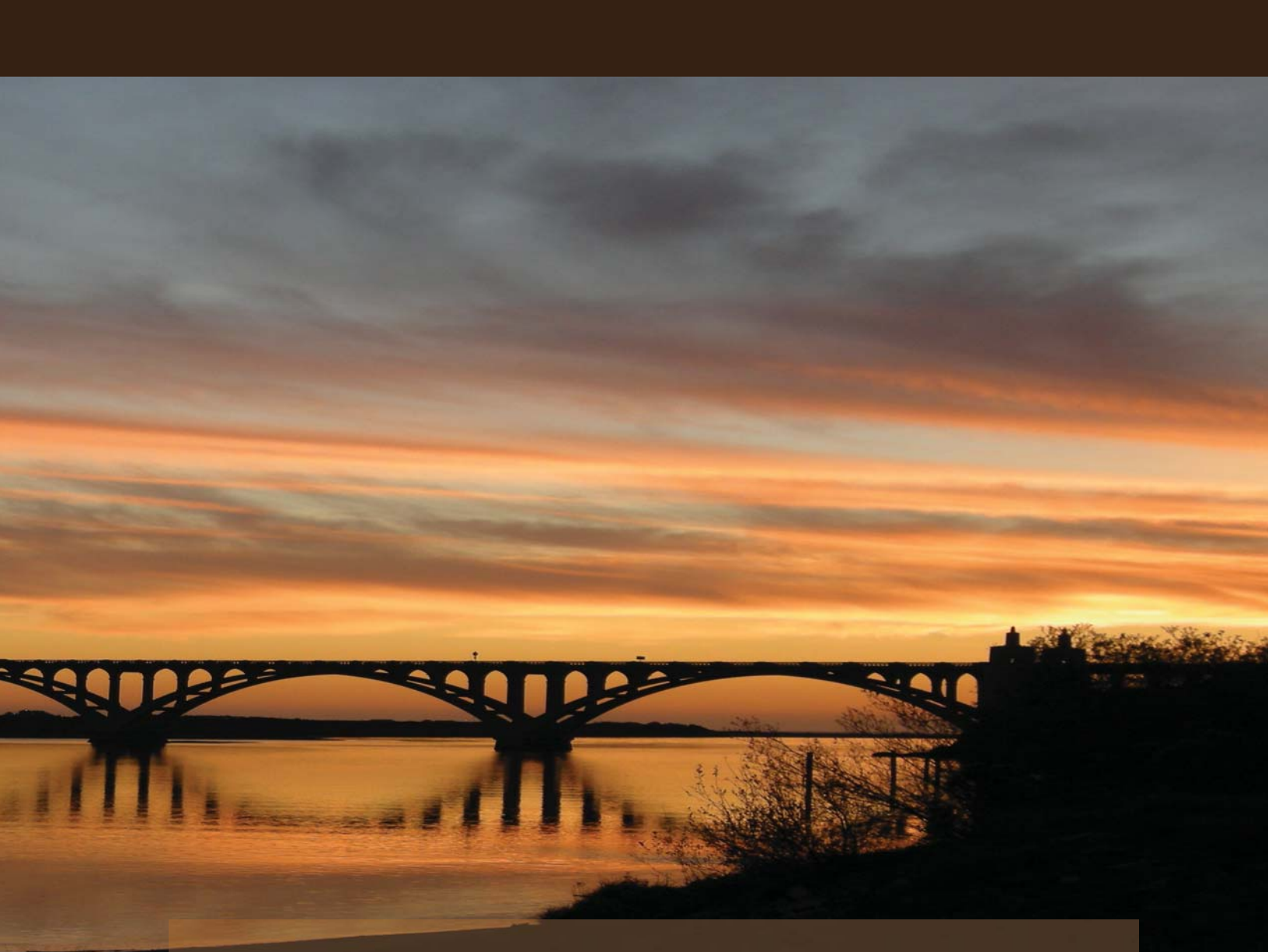
