## Warm Springs Tribal Council:



Tribal government is the local fiscal agent for state funds and provides accounting, legal, and human resources services as well as in-kind contributions of tribe-owned land and facilities.

### Outpatient

24-hour crisis evaluation and response, screening and assessment, prescribing, individual, group and family therapy for children and adults including Children-of-Alcoholics group therapy, anger management, women's groups, marital therapy

### Community Housing

## Community Counseling Center

provides and coordinates mental health, addictions and developmental disabilities services, quality improvement and utilization management of state-tribal shared services

### Addictions Services

#### Prevention

Education, early intervention and alternative activities for youth

#### Treatment

Outpatient treatment: Screening and assessment of addictions and physical health care needs, individual, group and family treatment for children and adults, intensive outpatient treatment, co-occurring disorders treatment\*

Residential services: referrals to Christie Care (kids) and Healing Lodge (adults)

Detox: referrals to BestCare, NARA

#### Recovery

Aftercare groups, case management, monitored Antabuse, Supported Housing\*, Supported Employment\*, child care, drop-in center at Community Counseling Center

### Developmental Disabilities Services

#### Program Administration

Eligibility determination, quality assurance, foster care licensing, family support, contracts, protective services.

#### Service Coordination

Crisis services, referral, person-centered planning, monitoring, advocacy, and information and training.
